UniCredit Leasing financed new Ikarbus's buses for AutoTransport Pančevo

In the ceremonial hall of the Museum of the City of Pancevo, on May 25th 2015, a contract has been signed for procurement of 12 new Ikarbus buses for public utility company Auto Transport Pancevo (ATP), financed by UniCredit Leasing Serbia. Delivery of the buses is planned by the end of this year.

Today's signing preceded a public tender announced by the ATP Pancevo in which the best chosen bidder was UniCredit Leasing Serbia Ltd. Besides the representatives of this company, also general manager of ATP, Milenko Krajnović, general manager of Ikarbus, Aleksandar Vićentić and councilor for public utilities and traffic of the City of Pančevo, Predrag Patić attended the signing.

These are new low-entry buses, of which 7 will be used for public transportation within Pancevo and 5 urban and suburban, which will be used for the transfer from Pancevo - Belgrade. Thanks to this procurement, the City of Pancevo will significantly modernize and improve its fleet, and special savings are expected when the fuel consumption is concerned, considering that these buses use engines with "Euro 5" standard. Also, the new vehicles will be in accordance with the requirements of the European Union, as they have filtered exhaust gases and thus are environmentally friendly and less harmful. In addition, citizens of Pancevo will ride in air-conditioned buses with free internet (WiFi), and most importantly, all vehicles will have adapted access for persons with disabilities.

Emiliano Steinfl, CEO of UniCredit Leasing Serbia, on this occasion stated: "This is the second public tender, this year, in which the UniCredit Leasing was elected the best financiers for public transport companies. I am very pleased that now the citizens of Pancevo and their guests will have the opportunity to feel comfortable and pleasant in the latest Mercedes buses made in Serbia."
