Ministry of Education, Science and Technological Development of Republic of Serbia and UniCredit Bank signed the Agreement on the payment of students loans and scholarships

Ministry of Education, Science and Technological Development of Republic of Serbia, during September, has signed the Agreement on providing the banking services in regards to the payment of pupils and students loans and scholarships and performing the certain professional tasks with UniCredit Bank. Namely, as from this school year, UniCredit Bank will perform all the activities in regards to processing and payment of pupils and students loans and scholarships which will be implemented in the branches of this Bank.

For pupil loan is determined monthly amount of 5,400 dinars and 8,400 dinars for a student which covers the costs of accommodation and food on a monthly basis in pupils' and students' dormitories.

Beneficiaries of pupil's loans, pupils and student scholarships as of today can open a free Student current account in any UniCredit Bank branch in Serbia. This account will be used for payment of loans and scholarships.

For opening the account, it is enough that students bring an ID and index, pupils who have an ID card and Report Book, while pupils who do not have an ID card, can open the account with Report Book, copy of the Birth Certificate and in the presence of their parents.

Payment of student's loans through the student's checks will be executed in the UniCredit Bank's branches. Students will be introduced with all the details of payment while receiving the check in student's

office of respective faculty. In Bor, Prokuplje, Blace, Bujanovac, Leposavić, Lešak, Zvečan, Kosovska Mitrovica and Kragujevac, students can cash in check in Post Offices.
