In order to improve Online Bank and in accordance with the requirements of clients who use this service, UniCredit Bank introduced additional functionality, the virtual exchange office. Thanks to this new functionality, bank's clients will be able to perform transactions such as buying or selling foreign currencies from their PCs, regardless the location and branch's working hours.

Virtual exchange office provides the possibility to perform currencies' exchanges for those currencies for which UniCredit Bank has formed effective exchange rates. This means that clients can exchange currencies such as euro, American dollar, Swiss franc, British pound, Swedish krone, Canadian dollar, Australian dollar, Norwegian krone, Danish krone and Hungarian forint. In order to use virtual exchange office, clients need to have opened an account in corresponding currency.
