In addition, customers can opt for the standing order service, thanks to which the bank based on the client's order performs regular payment of monthly bills, as well as for SMS service that informs them about all the payments on account or SMS Alarm Card which provides them security when using payment cards and allow them to know the amount of funds available at any moment.

Until the end of the year, clients have opportunity to try all services and only after the trial period to choose the ones that they will use. Upon completion of the promotion, the price of the monthly maintenance fee, depending on the choice of additional products and services will range from RSD 149 to RSD 449.
