UEFA Champions League Trophy Tour presented by UniCredit in Belgrade until tomorrow

UEFA Champions League Trophy on September 13 has started its 8th journey around Europe, and it will visit 16 cities in 5 countries. One of the stops of this year Trophy Tour is Serbia, where trophy is staying for 11 days, in period from September 22nd until October 2nd. The Trophy has already visited Niš, Subotica and Novi Sad and this weekend is exposed in Belgrade.

In order to enable as many people as possible to see the popular trophy and take pictures with it, UniCredit has organized events on the two locations in Belgrade. Today, October 1st, the Trophy is exposed at Republic Square until 9 p.m. while tomorrow, on Sunday, October 2nd, in period from 10 a.m. to 9 p.m. original Trophy will be exposed in UŠĆE Shopping Centre. On this occasion, all football fans will have the opportunity to get autographs from legendary goalkeeper of FC Red Star, Stevan Dika Stojanovic, but also to take a photo with the original trophy of the most prestigious European football club competition.
