UniCredit Bank's Super transfer – Gather a team and earn up to RSD 20,000

Taking into consideration the great interest of clients for Super transfer - Gather the team, UniCredit Bank has decided to extend the initiative, implemented for the third consecutive year, by the end of 2016, but also to increase the maximum amount of prize for all participants in the campaign, from RSD 10,000 to RSD 20,000.

As in previous editions of Super transfer, all existing clients of UniCredit Bank, private individuals, have the opportunity to recommend to their friends, colleagues or relatives to also become clients of the bank, and thus earn up to RSD 20,000. The maximum amount that can be obtained for one recommended client is RSD 2,000. The client receives RSD 1,000 to MasterCard gift card if recommended client opens an account in UniCredit Bank and transfers his/her salary or pension; an additional RSD 500, if the client within 45 days of opening the account, realize overdraft and/or credit card and an additional RSD 500, if the recommended client within 45 days of opening the account realize a cash loan.

In order to client receive the prize, it is necessary that the recommended client, by January 31st 2017, bring a filled leaflet for Super transfer, which can be found in any UniCredit Bank branch, open an Selector current account and receive at least one salary or pension on the account at UniCredit Bank.

All participants of Super transfer, clients who recommend UniCredit Bank, and recommended clients who have opened an account in UniCredit Bank, are entitled to additional benefits for dinar cash loan with insurance, with fixed or variable interest rate, as well as for housing loan with insurance at the National Mortgage Insurance Corporation.





In addition, clients who have already participated in the initiative and were rewarded in the period until May 1st 2016, may again, by referring new clients to UniCredit Bank, be rewarded with significantly higher amount, up to RSD 20,000.
