Young economists conference also this year gathers world's best researchers

For the sixth consecutive year, the Faculty of Economics in Belgrade, in cooperation with UniCredit and Universities Foundation, is organizing a two-day international "Young economists conference", which will be held 11th and 12th June in Belgrade. The conference aims at providing support to young researchers, from the field of economy and finance, coming from all around the world, for their further professional development. Besides the opportunity to publicly present their papers to academic elite from the country and abroad, also this year participants at the conference will compete for the title of the best research paperwork which UniCredit and Universities Foundation will reward with EUR 1,500.

Although numerous researchers from leading European and American universities applied for the award, only 11 researchers will have the opportunity to present their papers to reputable international and domestic professors from the field of economics and finance and to get advice on how to improve them for publication in some of the renowned international scientific journals. Young economists who will present their researches this year are coming from the world's leading universities such as the University of Zurich and Swiss Finance Institute, Vienna Graduate School of Finance, Paris School of Economics, University of Michigan, London School of Economics, and many others.

At the end of the second day of the conference, after all papers are presented, Program Committee shall, in accordance with the participants' presentations and pre-defined criteria, choose the best paperwork for which UniCredit and Universities Foundation has provided the prize.
